- 29. A RESOLUTION RANKING PROFESSIONAL DESIGN FIRMS FOR THE DISTRICT'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING DISTRICT OFFICIALS TO NEGOTIATE CONTRACT TERMS WITH THE MOST QUALIFIED PROFESSIONAL DESIGN FIRMS PURSUANT TO SECTION 153.69 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.**

WHEREAS, the District is considering a capital improvement project; and

WHEREAS, the District has requested proposals from Professional Design Firms to evaluate its school buildings and properties and provide master planning and design services; and

WHEREAS, the District has evaluated the statements of qualifications of professional design firms submitted by professional design firms; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 153.69 states that following this evaluation, the District shall select and rank no fewer than three firms which it considers to be the most qualified to provide the required professional design services;

WHEREAS, based on the District's evaluation, the District finds that the top three qualified professional design firms for the Community Engagement and Facility Assessment portions of the project are MKC Associates Inc, ThenDesign Architecture, Ltd and DiMaio Architects; and

WHEREAS, based on the District's evaluation, the District finds that the top three qualified professional design firms to provide Architectural Design Services are a combination of MKC Associates Inc, ThenDesign Architecture, Ltd and DiMaio Architects;

WHEREAS, due to the complexity of this construction project, the District finds that two professional design firms are necessary to provide Architectural Design Services on the project; and

WHEREAS, the District finds that MKC Associates Inc. and ThenDesign Architecture, Ltd are equally qualified to provide Architectural Design Services for the project; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 153.69 further states that the District shall then negotiate a contract with the firm(s) ranked most qualified to perform the required services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the North Royalton City School District, County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, that:
