**A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION OF
THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT BONDS
IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$54,300,000 TO THE
ELECTORS OF THE NORTH ROYALTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2012, this Board adopted a resolution declaring the necessity of submitting to the electors of this School District the question of the issuance of bonds (the Bonds) in the aggregate principal amount of \$54,300,000 and the levying of a tax to provide for the payment of the debt charges on the Bonds and any anticipatory securities at an election to be held in the School District on November 6, 2012, a copy of which resolution was certified to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, thereafter, the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer certified to this Board that the total tax valuation of the School District is \$1,058,125,920, and the estimated average annual property tax levy throughout the stated maximum maturity of the Bonds that would be required to pay the interest thereon and retire the principal thereof over 35 years is 2.65 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 26.5 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the North Royalton City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board determines to proceed with submitting to the electors pursuant to Section 133.18 of the Revised Code, at an election to be held on November 6, 2012, the question of issuing Bonds in the amount of \$54,300,000 for the purpose of constructing, renovating, remodeling, rehabilitating, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving buildings and facilities, and preparing, equipping and otherwise improving real estate and interests therein, for School District purposes, and levying a tax to pay the debt charges on the Bonds and on any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds. The average annual property tax levy required to pay those debt charges has been estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to be 2.65 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 26.5 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, and this Board estimates that the tax for debt charges will first be levied in 2012 and first be collected in calendar year 2013.

Section 2. The Treasurer of this Board is authorized and directed to certify to the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections not later than the close of business on Wednesday, August 8, 2012: (i) a copy of the resolution adopted by this Board on May 10, 2012, declaring the necessity of the bond issue and providing for the principal of the Bonds to be paid over a maximum of 35 years, which number of years is hereby certified to the Board of Elections, and which resolution is hereby ratified and confirmed together with all actions heretofore taken in conformance therewith; (ii) the certifications of the County Fiscal Officer as to the total tax valuation of the School District and the estimated average annual property tax levy; and (iii) a copy of this resolution. This Board hereby requests that the Board of Elections give notice of the election and prepare the necessary ballots and supplies for the election in accordance with law.

Section 3. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken, and all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
