 - **Superintendent's Update:**

Mr. Vittardi reported on the administrative evaluation process.

The process that is going to be used in the search for the high school principal was reviewed along with the anticipated timeline.

The Support Staff Person of the Year and the Teacher of the Year were announced this week. Bryan Sheffield, Support Staff Person of the Year and Carmen Rademaker, Teacher of the Year will be honored at the North Royalton Education foundation reception on April 27.

Mr. Vittardi provided an update on the stadium renovation project.

The new district web site is very close to being ready to go active.

An update on the implementation of the organizational audit was provided.

Mr. Gurka reviewed the information he received from CVCC member districts regarding their reports on bullying.

Mr. Gurka also reviewed the latest statistics regarding the fill rate and satisfaction with Renhill Staffing Services on procuring substitute teaches.

The athletic event worker pay schedule is being reviewed and a revised schedule will be presented for consideration for implementation in the 2011-2012 school year.

Mr. Presot provided an update on the Food Service Program.

The relocation of the cell tower currently located at the football stadium is still scheduled to proceed. An agreement to this effort will be on the regular meeting agenda if it is ready.

Mr. Presot discussed the possibility of creating a Mechanics Helper position in the Transportation Department. A groundskeeper/Laborer position will be posted.
