7. **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION.** The public is invited to speak to any of the agenda items and other school topics at this time. Comments should be limited to five minutes. There were no speakers from the audience.

8. **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Building & Grounds – Mr. Reinhard gave the following report:

1. The maintenance department is in the process of re-wiring and re-lamping the High School Industrial Arts Computer lab to prepare it for the new classes that will be taught this coming year. All of the desk units have been moved around to accommodate the students and technology that is needed. We have also changed out the lighting to make it more energy efficient.
2. Upgrades to the baseball and softball field backstops are just about completed. Additional asphalt work will be completed this year to also make the area more accessible for fans.
3. Summer cleaning of the buildings is going very well. The crews are emptying out each of the classrooms and other areas and washing walls, scrubbing and waxing floors, cleaning desks, etc... So far everything is on schedule and moving along.
4. Stadium Project- The visitors bleachers are about 95% complete and just waiting on some of the final banner rail items to arrive so it can be finished. The field is going to get the final grade tile work done this week and stoned over in the next few days. Sometime over the next two weeks the synthetic turf will arrive as well. Once it arrives, it takes about 3 weeks to install. The home bleachers are under construction. The steel framing should be done in the next few days and then the aluminum foot boards and seating will be installed. Tentative completion date for the bleachers in August 11th. The press box should be arriving in the next two weeks. At this point, we are still on target to have everything done in time for the first athletic contests of the year.

N. Royalton Recreation Board – Mr. Reinhard

There is no report on Baseball. The soccer season has ended. Men's softball is still working on catch up by having double headers. Football registration is wrapping up/ at Middle School in August. Working of lighting fields – field 8 is on a timer.

Other Items: Dog Show, 7/15; Fishing Derby, 7/13

The next Rec. Board meeting is July 26 at 6:00 pm at the City Hall. No meeting in August.

Transportation – Mr. Reinhard

On June 29th we had the second of our four annual Highway Patrol bus inspections for this year. We had 21 buses prepared for inspection. The inspection team could only inspect 20 buses in the time allotted. We had 15 of 20 pass inspection. The failures for the most part were due to corrosion and repairs are underway. The inspection team did re-inspect the only failure from the first round and found those repairs acceptable. Of the 69 buses in our fleet we currently have 35 buses endorsed for the 2011-2012 school year. 5 buses are now on the list to be re-inspected. Our next inspection date is July 28th and our goal is to have 20 buses prepared for inspection. As of this am, 8 are completed and a few more are close.

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In the office, the focus is on routing for the next school year. We are scrutinizing the efficiency of both mainstream and special needs bus routes.

We continue to work on professional development. The office staff had 3 ½ hours of online training for the Versatrans routing software on July 8th.

Kurtz Brothers has taken care of repairs to the drive at the new bus facility. The paving and striping of the lot is complete. Other than a few finishing touches, the new facility is ready to go.

Policy Committee- Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

Policy Committee did not have a meeting this month. As we discussed at the Board Work Session last we will hold off on having a first reading on the recommended Finances and Fiscal Operations policies until the August Board Work Session, so the Board will have more time to review everything.

Legislative Liaison Update-Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

State budget update

On June 27, the joint Conference Committee on the biennial state budget voted on party lines (4-2) to report out the final version of HB 153. The next day, the Senate voted to approve of the compromise and on Wednesday of that week, the House voted to approve the compromise legislation. On Thursday June 30, the Governor signed the bill into law just in time for the new fiscal year. Governor Kasich's original budget called for the North Royalton School District to lose about \$4.9 million dollars in state funding over the course of the 2 year state budget. However because of our Board Resolution, my testimony down at Statehouse, and the Community contacting our State Representatives and Senator our district is only going to lose about \$3.4 million dollars. It is still terrible that the state is cutting funding to public education when we need to invest more in it as a state. But I do want to thank everyone for being so involved and engaged throughout the budget process! Some of the final changes in the budget included:

- Health care pooling option for local government employees' coverage: optional, self-insurance and other pools could still exist as long as they meet best practices and benchmarks.
- Mandatory teacher evaluations based on multiple measures, with 50% based on student performance. The State Board of Education will develop the framework; school districts will adopt after their current bargaining contracts expire.
- Criteria must be developed for these evaluation categories: "accomplished," "proficient," "developing" and "ineffective."
- Prohibits using seniority for reductions in force (RIF) or rehiring, except when evaluations are comparable.
- School districts receiving federal Race to the Top (RttT) funds must use pay-for-performance criteria under a schedule based on license and evaluations.
- School districts NOT receiving RttT funds must use either performance-based salary schedule or current law.
- Principals or other employees could also serve as a school district's gifted education coordinator if qualified.
- Removes the provision allowing home-schooled students to participate in extracurricular activities.
- Requires Ohio Department of Education (ODE) to make recommendations to the legislature for students over age 22 to be enrolled tuition-free in a school district or charter school dropout recovery and prevention schools.
- Removes the provision prohibiting the selling of services to a charter school by a sponsor.
- Reinstates the moratorium on new e-schools until 2013, then allows up to five new schools each year thereafter.
- Allows charter schools that do not have a sponsor to apply to the ODE for approval to operate.

Statehouse update

Legislature is on Summer Recess. However the House and Senate have scheduled a full session for Wednesday, July 13, although at this time the formal session calendar has not yet been posted.

Governor Kasich

Gov. John Kasich has begun his process of developing a new school funding model. The recently adopted state budget includes a "bridge" formula to distribute the current K-12 education funding appropriation. While this "bridge" formula is written into House Bill HB 153, the governor has stated that he would try to develop a new formula for implementation as early as July 1, 2012. Any new formula would require legislative action. The governor has assigned the task of developing this new model to Barbara Mattei-Smith, assistant policy director for education. Mattei-Smith is reaching out to various constituencies to discuss what the underlying principles of a school funding model should be. This is something I plan to follow very closely and as a Board we need to get involved with this process.

Operation North Royalton Cares-Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

As I stated in our Work Session I am working to organize the 2nd Annual Operation North Royalton Cares. Operation North Royalton Cares benefits families of students in need of basic school supplies in the North Royalton Community. The program is again supported by the North Royalton City School District in coordination with the City of North Royalton Office on Aging and Human Services. The mission is to collect school supplies for children and families in need, living in North Royalton. Throughout the week there will be various drop off locations throughout the city for community members to donate items. The week long drive will go from August 8th - August 14th. So far I have gotten word today that St. Albert the Great Church and Howard Hanna Reality will be participating again. I am still in the process of working out all the details. We help over 59 students in the district and 32 families last year.

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Financial Advisory – Mrs. Reinkober – No Report

Family and Civic Engagement – Mrs. Reinkober - No Report

CVCC – Mrs. Hannan gave the following report.

CVCC was recently ranked #1 out of the 91 Career-Technical Planning Districts in Ohio, according to the Ohio Career-Technical Education 2009-2010 Secondary Career-Technical Planning District Workforce Development Performance Reports. This is the career-technical education version of the state report cards, which all public school districts in Ohio receive.

Dr. Celena Roebuck, Superintendent, and I will host a Vision8 meeting with North Royalton business leaders in August. The purpose of the meeting is to seek their input on how CVCC can meet business and community needs and build a communication forum between schools and industry.

Summer Camp was a big hit. 298 campers attended, 48 campers were from North Royalton.

On Saturday, October 1, 2011, CVCC celebrates its 40th year anniversary. A day of family fun and activity centered around Career and Technical Education is planned. More details will follow.

Associate districts reports from Brecksville, Cuyahoga Heights, Garfield Heights, and Independence was shared. Brecksville: The district graduated 407 students in June. They are facing their fourth round of cuts, totaling another 1.2 million. Twelve additional staff were cut, this makes 14 1/2 percent of staff who have been laid off. Employees have seen their health benefits contributions increase by 15% and the district has phased out pick-ups on the pick-ups.

Cuyahoga Heights: The district graduated 72 students in June. A 6.9 mill levy is on the ballot in August. They have cut 1.8 million from their budget. Currently, the district is under a fraud investigation concerning their purchasing. CVCC treasurer is employed part-time assisting the district until a new treasurer can be hired.

Garfield Heights: The district continues to change jobs around to meet the needs and the budget. An operating levy will be on the November ballot.

Independence: The district graduated 120 students in June. Many of their key employees are leaving (Superintendent, Treasurer, board secretary, High School principal, Curriculum Director, basketball and volley ball coach.) Some of these positions have been filled with inside hires. Independence is undecided as to whether it will be on the November ballot.

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF NORTH ROYALTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING TAX LEVY, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.194 THROUGH 5705.197 OF THE REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2011, this Board adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to submit to the electors of the District the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation, as described below, a copy of which resolution was certified to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, that County Fiscal Officer has certified to this Board that the total tax (assessed) valuation of the District is \$1,051,193,170 and that the estimated annual tax levy required throughout the life of the proposed levy to produce the annual amount of \$4,395,000 as set forth in that resolution, calculated in the manner provided by Section 5705.195 of the Revised Code, is 4.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 44 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the North Royalton City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board hereby determines to proceed with the submission to the electors at an election to be held on November 8, 2011, of the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation (commencing with a levy on the tax list and duplicate for the year 2012 to be first distributed to the Board in calendar year 2013) in order to raise the amount of \$4,395,000 each year for ten years for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of this District, at the annual tax rate as is necessary to raise that amount, which rate is currently estimated by the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer to be 4.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 44 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

Section 2. The Treasurer is authorized and directed to certify to the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections copies of this resolution and the resolution of this Board and certificate of the County Fiscal Officer referred to in the preambles hereto, on or before August 10, 2011. This Board hereby requests that the Board of Elections give notice, prepare the ballots, and make other necessary arrangements for the submission of this question to the electors of this District, all in accordance with law.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.

Resolution Abolishing the Position of Clerk-Typist (9 Month) Pursuant to a
Realignment/Reconfiguration Of Pupil Services Support Staff Positions

WHEREAS, the Board is desirous of enhancing the efficient operation and effectiveness in the support staff positions within the Office of Pupil Services; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Pupil Services presently utilizes the following support staff positions: Clerk-Typist (9 Month); Office Secretary (12 Month); Administrative Assistant (12 Month) and Administrative Assistant to the Director – Pupil Services (12 Month); and
