Building and Grounds – Mr. Reinhard gave the following report:

1. Progress on the stadium renovation project is going well. The retaining walls have been completed and the construction company is currently working on the sidewalks and the handicap ramps that lead to the bleachers. We are anticipating the bleachers to start to be installed in the next two weeks.
2. The replacement roofing project at the high school is in the final stages. New roof has been installed, and the roofers are in the process of putting on the final cap sheet. The metal work will be done shortly afterwards.
3. Mr. Presot has visited with each of the building custodians and checked the progress of the summer cleaning crews and all is going according to schedule.
4. The new fence at the practice soccer field has been completed and is ready for the team to start using for the upcoming season.

Legislation – Ms. Reinkober stated there was no July report and the legislature has recessed for the summer.

Financial Advisory Committee – Mrs. Reinkober stated there was no July report.

Health and Wellness Committee-Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

The Health and Wellness Committee is on recess for the summer and will meet again when school is back in session.

City Earth Energy Environment Committee- Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

City Earth Energy Environment Committee met on July 7th. Residents can now recycle 24/7. The service department has installed three convenience stations, which enables residents to drop off recyclables anytime they want to at the following locations: Heasley Field, 5100 Wallings Road; Memorial Park, 14600 State Road; and the North Royalton Service Center, 11545 Royalton Road. The committee had some more discussion on next year's city recycling calendar and offered some suggestions for alternative ways to fund it. The next EEE committee meeting will be held on September 1st at 7pm at City Hall.

School Green Team- Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

School Green Team is also on recess for the summer and will meet again when school is back in session as well.

Policy Committee- Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

Policy Committee did not have a meeting last month and nothing new to report.

Transportation – Mr. Reinhard submitted the following report:

We currently have 35 buses that have been approved for use during the 2010 – 2011 school year. We have 1 bus that needs to be re-inspected and that repair is complete. Our next bus inspection is scheduled for July 29th. Our goal is to have 20 buses prepared for inspection. We currently have 5 buses complete or very near complete. We also have 5 buses that are out for sublet repairs that should be complete soon. We also have a date change for our final inspection. That date has been moved from August 6th to August 13th.

We are moving along with the new Versatrans routing software. All a.m. routes have been completed and we are currently assigning students to the stops. As we are doing this, we are fine tuning the routes for efficiency. When this process is complete, we will be able to mirror the route for the p.m. runs. We also have the special needs runs in rough draft form and we are awaiting any changes to these runs.

CVCC– Mrs. Hannan submitted a copy of the CVCC Five-Year forecast to be distributed to the Board members. She also stated that the CVCC has a newly formed finance committee. The committee is not being formed to promote levies. Nor, is it an oversight committee. The committee is charged with creating public awareness of CVCC's financial status and to act as the reviewers of the audit report each year as recommended by the State Auditor's office. Mrs. Hannan also announced that beginning in August CVCC will become a test center for certifications in Microsoft Office Specialist 2007, Adobe Certified Associate, and IC3 through Certiport.
