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1. **CALL TO ORDER.** President Anne Reinkober called the Special Meeting of the North Royalton Board of Education to order at 6:00 p.m., September 8, 2011, at the North Royalton Board Office.

 - **Superintendent's Update:**

Mr. Vittardi thanked everyone for their involvement with the opening and dedication of the stadium.

A professional development day for the staff to work on curriculum will be held on September 14th.

Mr. Presot reviewed Flyer Central, an addition to the District's website that is now available for community and school groups to post flyers about their organization and events.

Mr. Vittardi noted that the constant Contact system is gaining more users daily.

The next SCENE will be held on September 29th and will focus on student achievement.

The State of the Schools address will be on October 19th at Carrie Cerino's.

Mr. Vittardi has been asked to serve on the NOTA Board.

The District's Title I funding has increased and a portion will be allotted to increase services to utilize those funds.

Mr. Presot reviewed the events scheduled for the community health fair which will be held on October 29th.

The relocation of the cell tower is under way and is scheduled to be completed on September 21st.

The stadium project has entered the punch list phase.

Mr. Presot reviewed a proposal from GonzOil regarding the District's property at Abbey Road.
