5. **RECOGNITION OF GUESTS AND PRESENTATIONS.** Dr. John Kelly presented several pieces of framed ribbon from the ribbon cutting commemorating the opening of Serpentine Stadium. He described the event as exceptional and attributed the success to the efforts of the city, school staff, students, parents, and community as a whole working together.

Next month student activity presentations will resume.

7. COMMITTEE REPORTS

Building & Grounds – Mr. Reinhard

- The stadium project is in the final stages. The contractors are coming back currently to complete punch list items. The track surfacing company has started the work on the synthetic track surfacing. This work is very weather sensitive and we have developed a plan to work on days for the next several weeks. The plan will need to be modified as weather may be a factor over the next few weeks.
- New electronic sign board has been installed at the board office. This sign board will allow us to notify the community of upcoming events and information.

City Recreation Board – Mr. Reinhard

There was no August meeting. The next meeting will be August 27th.

Transportation – Mr. Reinhard

All buses but 1 of our 69 have been inspected by the Highway Patrol and approved for use during the 2011-2012 School year. The only bus that has not been approved is in the body shop for floor and floor brace repair due to corrosion.

We have received word from the Ohio EPA that we have been awarded an additional Clean Diesel School Bus grant in the amount of \$86,133. We were one of only six districts to be awarded grant money which is in addition to our previous grant last year that was used to purchase catalytic converters. This grant will purchase 23 onboard bus heaters that will greatly reduce cold weather start up emissions and fuel usage. The state estimates an annual reduction of 30.8 lbs of small particle pollution and 1,120 lbs of nitrogen oxide with the use of these heaters. These figures will be compounded every year the bus is in use. The engines on these buses will be warm when the driver arrives in the morning as they are timer activated. This will greatly reduce the fuel used for cold start warm up.

Here in the office we have been busy with the start up of the new school year. We have been able to meet the challenge presented by all the registrations we received in August along with 146 Alternate Transportation Forms we have received after the deadline of July 22nd.

Curriculum & Pupil Services – Mrs. Dolezal

On Wednesday, September 14 teachers will be taking part in a professional development program that centers on improving student achievement. The purpose of this professional development is focused on a district-wide commitment to the Ohio Improvement Process. In this process, a group of teachers and administrators from across the district called the District Leadership Team analyzed student data, resource allocations, curriculum, and management. This led to the development of goals, strategies and action steps that address student achievement and are aligned to the Strategic Plan. During this professional development day, teachers will examine the new Common Core Standards and align the curriculum with their instruction, learn about new methods of collecting and analyzing student assessment data, and then collaborating by grade levels or departments to put this information into classroom instruction.

Each building now has a Building Leadership Team which will examine building specific student data and create strategies and action steps that help reach the goals that were determined by the District Leadership Team. These teacher leaders will meet for one half-day a month to continue this process and work towards meeting the strategies and action steps created at the building level. These Building Leadership Team meetings will begin this week.

Grade levels and departments will continue to meet on a regular basis during early release days and after school staff meetings to develop common assessments which will help students and teachers know what concepts are mastered and which need additional instruction and support.

Policy Committee - Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

Policy Committee did not have a meeting this month.

Legislative Liaison Update - Mr. Langshaw gave the following report:

On August 13th attended the Ohio School Boards Association’s State Legislative Platform Committee Meeting in Columbus. We will be reviewed the proposed amendments to the platform, and voted on which ones to submit to the OSBA Delegate Assembly for approval. There was also a brief legislative update that was given.

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On August 27th met with State Representative Mike Dovilla during his District Office Hours at the Strongsville Library. I expressed concerns regarding the governor’s plans to create a new school funding model and the possible negative effect it could have on districts like North Royalton. It was very positive to learn that a bipartisan, bicameral Suburban Caucus in the legislature was recently formed to advocate for the interest of suburbs. I believe this is a very positive step forward and I plan to see what ways local school districts like ours can benefit from such lobbying efforts.

HB 136

HB 136 is probably going to be voted out of the House Education Committee later this month. Primarily, the bill:

- Expands vouchers to students in all school districts, regardless of the academic report card rating of the school building or school district. The only qualifier for eligibility is household income. Students whose family income is less than \$95,000 would qualify.
 - Allows students currently enrolled in private schools to be eligible for the voucher.
 - Allows a parent to bank excess dollars for college if the private school tuition is less than the voucher amount.
 - Deducts funding for the voucher from the resident school district’s funding which could be extremely hurtful to our school district.

As I stated at the Work Session last week I believe we should do a board resolution regarding this issue and the negative impact HB 136 would have on our school district and send it to our representatives in Columbus.

CVCC – Mrs. Hannan

The handout "Did you know..." was distributed to board members at the meeting. This handout, highlighting many accomplishments of the CVCC, is part of the literature that CVCC prepared in anticipation of the November levy renewal campaign.

The CVCC was named a 2011 "Top Workplace" in Northeast Ohio as ranked by WorkplaceDynamics and published in The Plain Dealer.

The job placement surveys and reports of the past academic year and the class of 2010 follow-up surveys were shared with the board.

Jesse Yagl in Computer Networking Academy received third place at the BPA National competition.

The CVCC is celebrating its 40th year anniversary on October 1, 2011. A pancake breakfast and many activities are planned for the day beginning at 9:00 a.m. The CVCC is also hosting a 5K run on October 8, 2011 at the school's campus.

The North Royalton Vision 8 meeting was held in August. The mayor, Mr. Vittardi and several business owners were in attendance. The focus of the meeting was to brainstorm and explore how the CVCC can better prepare students for the workplace and to determine whether businesses were interested in any specialized training program.
