1. **CALL TO ORDER.** President Dr. John Kelly called the Special Meeting of the North Royalton Board of Education to order at 6:30pm, November 14, 2013, at the North Royalton Board Office.
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.** President John Kelly requested all present to join in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. **ROLL CALL.** Present: President Dr. John Kelly, Vice-President Anne Reinkober, Heidi Dolezal, Barbara Zindroski, Leonard Reinhard. Board Member Elect Dr. Susan Clark, Superintendent Gregory Gurka, Assistant Superintendent James Presot, and Treasurer Richard McIntosh were also in attendance.

4. **WORK SESSION**

Superintendent's Update

Mr. Gurka reviewed two pieces of pending legislation. H.B. 237 proposes the repeal of the Common Core. H.B. 8 would allow teachers and principals to carry firearms in schools.

Mr. Gurka reviewed the history of the bond issues proposed since the year 2000, the facility studies conducted and how the most recent bond issue was formulated.

John Kohl addressed the Board sharing his thoughts on the bond issue.

Mr. Gurka updated the Board on Medical reimbursements and pre-school assessments.

Mr. Presot, responding to a request from Mrs. Zindroski, reviewed a list of the properties owned by the district and a list of the buses and other vehicles owned by the district.

Mr. Presot reviewed the numbers of students eligible for free and reduced lunch.

Agenda Review

The board reviewed the regular meeting agenda.

Board President's Agenda

Dr. Kelly noted that the regular meeting minutes of October 14 now includes Mrs. Zindroski's comments on the appointment of Mr. Gurka. Dr. Kelly also asked if the correspondence Mrs. Zindroski received from Representative Dovilla and the email from Van Keating (OSBA) should be included in the minutes.

Following discussion the consensus of the Board was to add a notation at end of Ms. Zindroski's report noting that she also spoke to recent changes to Joint Vocational School District governance as enacted in House Bill 59 and her attendance at the Peple and Waggoner legal seminar regarding Peple & Waggoner seminar.
