Language Arts: (red)

2 red one subject spiral notebooks with holes
1" (or larger) red 3-ring binder filled with wide ruled loose leaf paper
5 dividers
2 red folders with pockets and clasps
Post-it notes (3x3)
Book cover size XL (red if possible) to fit an 11 ½ x 8 ½ x 1 ½ size book

R.I.C.A. (Reading in the Content Area) Math: (blue)

1 folder with pockets (any color) 1 ½" blue 3-ring binder with paper
5 dividers

Science: (green)

4 green folders with pockets and center clasps (one for each unit)
Green 3-subject spiral notebook

Social Studies: (orange)

1 ½" orange 3-ring binder
Orange pocket folder
5 dividers

Homeroom supplies (to be turned into homeroom teacher):

Large box of Kleenex, marked with name
One large package of disinfectant wipes (Clorox/Lysol brand ONLY - Jared's Law)
Old (but clean) sock for cleaning dry erase boards
Extra loose-leaf wide ruled paper

Supplies to be kept in your locker until needed (perhaps in an art bag or a Ziploc bag):

Colored pencils or Crayons, Scissors, Markers, Glue Stick, Scotch tape
Put your name on a pencil pouch & carry these supplies to EVERY class:

Blue or black pens, and additional colored pens
Thin Highlighters (assorted colors)

Other suggestions

- ✓ No rolling book bags please—they do not fit in student lockers
- ✓ Many students find a homework folder or accordion file helpful for organizing homework
- ✓ Please fill notebooks and folders with some loose leaf paper
- ✓ Please check in with students mid-year to see which supplies may require replenishing
