- 9. APPROVE RESOLUTION FOR NORTH ROYALTON CITY SCHOOLS TO WORK WITH CCG AUTOMATION - DESIGN ASSIST/STATE TERM SCHEDULING.** Resolve the Board of Education approve CCG Automation to work with the school district on their capital improvement projects through either design assist or through state term schedules.

WHEREAS, the District has passed a bond issue to renovate and add to the high school, selectively improve the middle school and build a new elementary school; and

WHEREAS, the District has been using CCG Automation to implement an energy management strategy; and

WHEREAS, the District believes that CCG Automation's efforts coupled with District efforts has reduced energy costs; and

WHEREAS, CCG Automation possess unique knowledge regarding the existing HVAC and Building Automation Systems which the District would like to utilize to assist the architect and engineers in designing the improvements to District facilities; and

WHEREAS, using CCG Automation through design assist or State Term Schedules will likely reduce construction costs and long term energy consumption due to their knowledge of the existing systems; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code permits design assist and the procurement of building automation systems through State Term Schedules.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education, that after careful consideration and evaluation of the information before it:

Section 1. This Board determines that CCG Automation should be involved in the capital improvement program through either the design assist process or via State Term Schedules in order to optimize the District’s previous investments in HVAC equipment and building automation systems and authorizing the Assistant Superintendent to work with the project team to develop CCG Automation’s role and to propose a contract or series of contracts for this Board’s consideration.

The Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions related to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board; and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable law.
